

HB 1654 -- JAYCEES DAY

SPONSOR: Sommer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill designates January 21 as "Jaycees Day" and encourages citizens to recognize the community service and civic engagement of Jaycees members.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is similar to the resolution that already passed out of committee. This commemoration of the 100th year of founding would provide significant public recognition as they embark on renewed efforts to grow engagement in the state.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Sommer and Charles David "Dave" Delaney.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
