

HB 1727 -- PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

Currently, children under the age of seven years old are required to wear a personal flotation device when on board any watercraft on the waters of Missouri. This bill names the provision "Hannah's Law" and raises the age until which a child is required to wear a personal flotation device to the age of 12. The bill also requires a child, under the age of 12, who is wading or swimming in navigable public waters more than three feet in depth to wear a personal flotation device. The bill exempts children from the personal flotation device requirement if supervised by a lifeguard.

This bill is the same as HB 409 (2019).
