

HB 1742 -- MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

SPONSOR: Sommer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill requires the Division of Motor Vehicles, within the Department of Revenue, to offer a one-time only three-year registration option for specified vehicles. Fee offices may collect an extra proportional fee for the three-year license sale.

This bill is the same as HCS HB 1566 (2018).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will fix an odd situation where some first purchasers of vehicles can only get a license for less than one year and then have to repurchase.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Sommer.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

OTHERS: Others testifying on the bill say they were available for any questions from the committee.

Testifying on the bill was the Department of Revenue.
