HB 1808 -- ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND INSTRUCTION (Wood)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Elementary and Secondary Education

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for HB 1808.

This bill requires the State Board of Education to amend the existing health or physical education academic performance standards, learning standards, and curriculum frameworks to include instruction on the use and evidence based effect of vapor products as defined in Section 407.925 RSMo.

This bill modifies the current work group members, to allow for more flexibility in appointees, and removes the requirement to hold three public hearings.

This bill adds tobacco and vapor products to the definition of drugs used in Sections 161.500 to 161.508, RSMo known as the "Drug Free Schools Act".
