HB 1934 -- PUBLIC SCHOOL RETIREMENT SYSTEM

SPONSOR: Wiemann

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Pensions by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules Administrative Oversight by a vote of 7 to 0.

This bill exempts information pertaining to the salaries and benefits of the executive director and employees of the Board of the Public School Retirement System of Missouri from being confidential.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will require the Public School Retirement System of Missouri to report the salary and benefits information of the director and employees of the system the same as all other public employee retirement systems in the state already do.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Wiemann and Office Of The Missouri State Treasurer.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
