HB 1989 -- VIDEO GAMING TERMINALS

SPONSOR: Merideth

This bill prohibits video gaming terminals in bars, convenience stores, gas stations, and restaurants that have not been approved by the Gaming Commission. Anyone who violates this provision is guilty of a class B misdemeanor for the first offense and a class A misdemeanor for the second and subsequent offenses.

The bill allows the Gaming Commission to impose civil penalties for violating this statute.
