

HB 2128 -- MOTOR VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS (Rone)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Agriculture Policy

This bill exempts vehicles towing trailers specifically designed to carry harvested cotton with a total length of not more than 93 feet from the size and length requirements for vehicles traveling on the state highways. The vehicle can also be used to transport hay within the state to areas affected by drought.

Currently, vehicle regulations relating to height, width, weight, length, and load restrictions for motor vehicles do not apply to emergency vehicles. The bill also removes the exemption as to weight and load restrictions.
