HB 2164 -- LAND SURVEY PROGRAM BUILDING

SPONSOR: Ross

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill requires the building that is the permanent headquarters of the Land Survey Program to be renamed as the "Robert E. Myers Building".

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that Robert E. Myers was a great gentleman. He was Missouri's first state land surveyor and worked on many legislative issues.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Ross; and Missouri Society of Professional Surveyors.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
