HB 2194 -- OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

SPONSOR: Ruth

This bill modifies provisions relating to off-highway vehicles.

The bill increases the:

- (1) Maximum width as measured from the outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim from 50 inches to 55 inches in the definition of an all-terrain vehicle for an off-highway use (Section 300.010, RSMo);
- (2) Maximum width as measured from the outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim from 50 inches to 55 inches and increases the maximum unladen dry weight from 2,000 to 2,500 pounds in the definition of a recreational off-highway vehicle (Section 301.010); and
- (3) Maximum width as measured from the outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim from 50 inches to 55 inches and increases the maximum dry weight from 600 to 1,500 pounds on nonhighway tires in the definition of an all-terrain vehicle for an off-highway use under the motor vehicle franchise practices sections in Chapter 407 and the public safety offenses section in Chapter 577.
