HB 2300 -- PEER REVIEW COMMITTEES

SPONSOR: Coleman (32)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Professional Registration and Licensing by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Consent" by the Standing Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 13 to 0.

This bill removes a sunset provision on peer review committees for architects, landscape architects, professional land surveyors, or professional engineers.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the process of peer review committees is very successful and that the removal of the sunset provision will allow for the committees to continue to enrich the careers of the impacted professionals.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Coleman; Burns and Mcdonnell; American Council Of Engineering Companies - Missouri; Missouri Society Of Professional Engineers; American Institute Of Architects Of Missouri; and Missouri Society of Professional Land Surveyors.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
