

HB 2322 -- CONSOLIDATION OF SPECIAL DISTRICTS

This bill authorizes the board of trustees of a reorganized common sewer district and a public water supply district to jointly petition the circuit court of the county containing the majority of the acreage of the two districts to allow the districts to consolidate into the reorganized sewer district. The petition must contain a plan of consolidation. The amended decree of incorporation will not become final until favorably voted upon by both the reorganized common sewer district and a public water supply district.

The bill also authorizes a common sewer district and a public water supply district to consolidate using the same procedure as for the consolidation of two common sewer districts, as specified in the bill.

Certain sewer districts are authorized to provide improvements and services within a sanitary sewer improvement area, and to make assessments to pay for all or part of the costs of improvements and services, including the cost of any principal or interest on temporary notes and revenue bonds.
