HB 2418 -- TRANSIENT GUEST TAXES

SPONSOR: Neely

Currently, a certain provision of law authorizes cities and counties described in the bill to impose, upon voter approval, a transient guest tax of between 2% and 5% per occupied room per night for tourism purposes.

This bill authorizes any city of the third classification with more than 9,000 but fewer than 10,000 inhabitants and located in more than one county to levy a transient guest tax upon voter approval. Currently, this applies to the city of Cameron.
