

HB 2625 -- DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

SPONSOR: Evans

This bill states that all hunting, fishing, and trapping records maintained by the Department of Conservation are closed records and shall not be released under the Sunshine Law. The name, address, email address, phone number and all other personal information of a landowner or person contained in any database maintained by the department relating to participation in a cost-share program or the reporting or sighting of any wild or feral animal is also a closed record and inaccessible to others unless the person whose information is contained in the database has granted written permission for release.
