HB 2634 -- TASK FORCE ON MUSIC THERAPIST

SPONSOR: Swan

This bill establishes the ""Joint Task Force on Music Therapist Licensure". The task force is composed of 13 members as described in the bill, including two members from the House of Representatives and two members from the Senate.

The task force will meet within 30 days if its creation and will review the current licensure for music therapists and develop a plan to protect public safety if music therapy procedures are utilized. The plan should include but not limited to analysis of risks for non-licensure, requirements and exemptions, and continuing education and training. The task force shall submit a report to the General Assembly before January 1, 2021.
