

HB 2648 -- LICENSING OF ACCOUNTANTS

SPONSOR: McGirl

Beginning June 30, 2021 this bill will require applicants for an accountant licensure to have at least 120 semester hours of college education at an accredited college or university recognized by the Missouri State Board of Accountancy with an accounting concentration or equivalent. The bill repeals requirements that applicants be a resident of the state, have a place of business in this state, or be regularly employed in this state.

This bill is the same as SB 1006 (2020).
