

HCR 63 -- SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

SPONSOR: Anderson

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Conservation and Natural Resources by a vote of 8 to 0 with 1 voting Present. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This resolution establishes the "Joint Committee on Solid Waste Management District Operations". The joint committee is composed of five members of the Senate and five members of the House of Representatives, with not more than three from each chamber being from the same party. The joint committee may hold hearings and prepare a report with its recommendations for any legislative action deemed necessary, for submission to the General Assembly by December 31, 2025, at which time the Joint Committee shall be dissolved.

This bill is similar to SCR 29 (2019).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this resolution would allow the Joint Committee on Solid Waste Management District Operations to complete the work it started last year. This would give it the time necessary to take an in depth look at how the districts function and if there are legislative opportunities to help the districts function more efficient and effectively.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Anderson.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
