HCR 67 -- AMERICAN HISTORY AND FOUNDERS MONTH

SPONSOR: Trent

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This resolution designates the month of November, with Election Day, Veteran's Day and Thanksgiving, as "National American History and Founders Month" to commemorate the nation's founders, Constitution, and history.

This bill is the same as HCR 47 (2019).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a good bill to recognize the importance of our country's founding and history. It can be recognized in schools and by other organizations.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Trent.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
