

HJR 96 -- REDISTRICTING

SPONSOR: Aldridge

Upon voter approval, this resolution requires the Missouri Department of Corrections and any federal agency operating a prison to provide the nonpartisan state demographer with information on the prison location, race, and last known address or residence of currently incarcerated persons. Personally identifying information is not required.

The nonpartisan demographer shall make use of the last known address if possible for purposes of state legislative redistricting and shall not count such persons as residents of the district where the prison is located. If an address is not known or provided, then individuals will be allocated to a state unit not determined by specific geography as provided by current law governing certain military and overseas persons.

This bill is the same as SJR 35 (2020).
