HJR 112 -- CONSERVATION SALES AND USE TAX

SPONSOR: Dinkins

Currently, the Missouri Department of Conservation collects a sales and use tax of .125%. Upon voter approval, this Constitutional amendment would reduce the tax collected by the Department of Conservation to 0.04166667% and levy additional sales and use taxes of 0.04166667% to provide additional money to be used by the Missouri Veterans' Commission and for the Department of Public Safety for the Sexual Assault Forensic Examination Program.

The Constitutional amendment would also require each tax to be approved by voters every eight years. If a majority of the voters fail to approve the continuance of one of the taxes, that tax will terminate at the end of the second fiscal year after the last election was held.
