

SB 913 -- PEER REVIEW PROCESS FOR DESIGN PROFESSIONALS

SPONSOR: Emery

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Regulatory Oversight and Reform by a vote of 7 to 0.

Provisions relating to the peer review process for architects, landscape architects, professional land surveyors, and professional engineers are set to expire on January 1, 2023. This bill repeals the expiration of those provisions.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the peer review process has been very successful and should be continued without a sunset.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Emery and American Institute of Architects of Missouri.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
