"performing his or her official duty; (4) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, [loans] lends, gives away, or delivers [any] a firearm to a person [less than] under eighteen years [old] of age without the consent of the [child's] recipient's custodial parent or guardian[;], provided[,] that this does not prohibit the delivery of [such weapons] a firearm to any peace officer or member of the Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his <u>or her</u> official duty; or [(3)] (5) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, [loans] lends, gives away, or delivers a firearm or ammunition for a firearm to a person who is intoxicated. 2. Unlawful transfer of weapons under subdivision (1) <u>or (2)</u> of subsection 1 of this section is a class E felony; unlawful transfer of weapons under [subdivisions (2) and] <u>subdivision (3), (4), or</u> (5) of subsection 1 of this section is a class A misdemeanor."; and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
