FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§84.344 - Residency Requirements

In response to similar legislation from this special session, SB 6, officials at the **City of St. Louis** stated the Fiscal Manager of the **St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department** assumes there would be no measurable fiscal impact from the passage of this legislation.

Oversight notes §84.344 removes the residency requirement for employees of the City of St. Louis Police Department. Oversight assumes this section of the proposal could have a potential <u>indirect</u> impact on the City of St. Louis (such as an increase in earnings tax collections if the removal of the residency requirement allows the City of St. Louis to hire additional officers that reside outside the city limits but will be employed within the city); however, Oversight assumes this section will have no direct fiscal impact on state or local government.
