AN ACT

To amend chapter 506, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to civil actions against peace officers, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 506, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 506.450, to read as follows:

- 506.450. 1. (1) A plaintiff who prevails in a lawsuit against a peace officer, as defined under section 590.010, who is charged with violating the plaintiff's constitutional rights shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees.
- (2) When a judgment is entered in favor of a defendant, the defendant shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees for defending claims the court finds frivolous.
- 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law, because a person has a constitutional right under the bill of rights of both the United States and Missouri Constitutions, qualified immunity shall not be a defense to liability under this section.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to fight violent crime in Missouri and

- 2 to protect our citizens and residents from the actions of law enforcement officers that jeopardize
- 3 the life and safety of our citizens and residents, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the
- 4 immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared
- 5 to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be
- 6 in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
