1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 137, Page 5, Section 160.415, Line 134, by  
2 inserting after the word, "revenues" the following:

3  
4 "beyond the annual amount required for repayment of debt of the Kansas City public school district as of  
5 December 1, 2020, and until the end term of such debt"; and

6  
7 Further amend said bill and section, Page 7, Line 225, by inserting after all of said line the following:

8  
9 "(10) On or before the twenty-eighth day of February of each year, the school district will adjust the  
10 February payment of local aid in an amount equal to the prior year's cost of serving students with disabilities  
11 less any amounts provided through local aid in accordance with subdivisions (3) and (4) of this subsection.

12 (a) This adjustment shall be calculated by determining the total cost as reported on the annual  
13 secretary of the board report for each charter schools and the school district, of department-defined special  
14 education instruction, tuition for special education programs, health, psychology, speech, audiology, OT, PT,  
15 VI, and special education transportation services divided by the prior year count of students reported in the  
16 December reporting as IEP-eligible. The school district and charter school shall, as part of their annual audit  
17 as required by section 165.111, include a report of all included expenditures coded to the department function  
18 codes that are included in this paragraph. Such report shall be made publicly available on the school district  
19 or charter school website in a searchable format or as a downloadable and searchable document.

20 (b) This cost will be reduced by the prior year's revenue for each charter school and the school  
21 district reported as state aid, local aid as described in this subsection, high needs funds, and federal IDEA  
22 special education revenues.

23 (c) Each charter school's or school district's overpayment or underpayment shall be the result of the  
24 difference in their cost, net of revenues received, for the IEP count utilized for the final state aid payment of  
25 the prior fiscal year.

26 (d) Any underpayment or overpayment amount shall be remitted under the schedules in paragraphs  
27 (a) and (b) of subdivision (7) of this subsection.

28 (e) Any funding provided to a school district or charter school through federal, state, or other  
29 funding, in order to reimburse that school district or charter school for expenses incurred by the school  
30 district or charter school, shall not be considered "local aid" for purposes of this section, subject to  
31 distribution to the school district or charter school that did not incur the expense.

32 (f) The requirements in this subdivision shall apply to all school years ending on or before June 30,  
33 2022."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
