1 AMEND House Bill No. 920, Page 1, Sections 77.070 and 77.450, by removing all of said sections
2 from the bill; and

3
4 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 115.121, Lines 1 to 7, by deleting said section and lines and
5 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 "115.121. 1. The general election day shall be the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
8 November of even-numbered years.

9 2. The primary election day shall be the first Tuesday after the first Monday in August of
10 even-numbered years.

11 3. The election day for the election of political subdivision and special district officers shall
12 be the first Tuesday after the first Monday in April each year, and shall be known as the general
13 municipal election day.

14 4. The election day for bond elections, tax measures, and any other local ballot measure
15 submitted to a vote of the people by a political subdivision or special district of this state shall be
16 held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November or as otherwise authorized under this
17 section or law except that this subsection shall supersede any statutory authorization to hold such
18 elections on the municipal election day or during the month of February; however, this subsection
19 shall not apply to any elections held under section 115.123 or held under the authority of a city or
20 county charter.

21 115.123. 1. All public elections shall be held on Tuesday. Except as provided in
22 subsections 2 and 3 of this section, and section 247.180, all public elections shall be held on the
23 general election day, the primary election day, the general municipal election day, the first Tuesday
24 after the first Monday in November, or on another day expressly provided by city or county charter,
25 and in nonprimary years on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in August. ~~[Bond elections may~~
26 ~~be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in February but no other issue shall be included~~
27 ~~on the ballot for such election.]~~

28 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, an election for a
29 presidential primary held pursuant to sections 115.755 to 115.785 shall be held on the second
30 Tuesday after the first Monday in March of each presidential election year.

31 3. The following elections shall be exempt from the provisions of subsection 1 of this
32 section:

- 33 (1) Bond elections necessitated by fire, vandalism or natural disaster;
34 (2) Elections for which ownership of real property is required by law for voting;
35 (3) Special elections to fill vacancies and to decide tie votes or election contests; and
36 (4) Tax elections necessitated by a financial hardship due to a five percent or greater decline

1 in per-pupil state revenue to a school district from the previous year.

2 4. Nothing in this section prohibits a charter city or county from having its primary election
3 in March if the charter provided for a March primary before August 28, 1999.

4 5. Nothing in this section shall prohibit elections held pursuant to section 65.600, but no
5 other issues shall be on the March ballot except pursuant to this chapter."; and

7 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
8 accordingly.
