1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 91, Page
2 1, Section A, Line 10, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "21.155. 1. The accounts committee of the senate and the accounts committee of the house
5 of representatives shall each, on January fifteenth of each year, set the total number of employees
6 for their respective houses, taking into account the rates of pay set as provided in section 21.150 and
7 the appropriations made therefor.

8 2. During any session of a general assembly, each representative may employ one
9 stenographer or secretary, and the remainder of the officers and employees of the house of
10 representatives, except the elective officers thereof, shall be selected or appointed by the members
11 of the majority party of the house of representatives.

12 3. During any session of a general assembly, each senator may employ one stenographer or
13 secretary, and the accounts committee of the senate, as provided in this section, may employ and
14 assign such other employees as may be necessary for the operation of the senate.

15 4. The senate and house of representatives may each~~[, by resolution,]~~ continue in
16 employment at their regular salaries, such number of efficient employees of each body after any
17 adjournment of a regular session or sine die adjournment of the general assembly as may be
18 necessary for operation of their respective houses~~[, and the resolutions shall also set the terms of~~
19 ~~such employment]~~. All employees assigned to individual members of the general assembly or to
20 committees shall be divided between the majority and minority parties in proportion to the number
21 of members of each party in the respective bodies."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
