1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute No. 2 for Senate Bill No. 26, Page 2,
2 Section 557.045, Line 15, by inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "565.093. 1. As used in this section, the following terms and phrases mean:

5 (1) "Harassment", verbal or nonverbal behavior by a person that would cause a reasonable
6 person to be placed in fear of receiving bodily harm;

7 (2) "Recreation athletic contest official", any referee, umpire, coach, instructor,
8 administrator, staff person, or recreation employee of any public or quasi-public recreation program;

9 (3) "School athletic contest official", any referee, umpire, coach, instructor, administrator,
10 staff person, or school or school board employee of any public or private elementary or secondary
11 school.

12 2. A person commits the offense of harassment of a school or recreation athletic contest
13 official if the harassment occurs under the following circumstances:

14 (1) While the school or recreation athletic contest official is actively engaged in the
15 conducting, supervising, refereeing, or officiating of a school-sanctioned interscholastic athletic
16 contest or a sanctioned recreation athletic contest; or

17 (2) In the immediate vicinity of a school-sanctioned interscholastic athletic contest or a
18 sanctioned recreation athletic contest and is based on the official's performance in the conducting,
19 supervising, refereeing, or officiating of a school-sanctioned interscholastic athletic contest or a
20 sanctioned recreation athletic contest.

21 3. A person who commits the offense of harassment of a school or recreation athletic contest
22 official shall be fined no more than five hundred dollars, imprisoned for no more than ninety days,
23 or both.

24 4. In addition to any other penalty imposed, the court shall order the person:

25 (1) To perform forty hours of court-approved community service work; and

26 (2) To participate in a court-approved counseling program that may include anger
27 management, abusive behavior intervention groups, or any other type of counseling deemed
28 appropriate by the court. Any costs associated with the counseling program shall be paid by such
29 person.

30 5. Participation in the community service and counseling program required under subsection
31 4 of this section shall not be suspended.

32 569.154. 1. A person commits the offense of entry or remaining on site of a school or
33 recreation athletic contest if such person, without authority, goes into or upon or remains in or upon,
34 or attempts to go into or upon or remain in or upon, any immovable property or other site or location
35 that belongs to another and that is used for any school or recreation athletic contest, including any
36 area in the immediate vicinity of the site or location of the school or recreation athletic contest, after

1 having been forbidden to do so, either orally or in writing, by any owner, lessee, or custodian of the
2 property or by any other authorized person.

3 2. A person who violates subsection 1 of this section shall be fined no more than five
4 hundred dollars, imprisoned for no more than six months, or both."; and
