(2) This state and its agencies shall provide one copy of each of the following, free of 14 charge, if needed by an individual seeking to obtain a form of personal identification described in 15 16 subsection 1 of this section [in order to vote] for voting: 17 (a) A birth certificate; (b) A marriage license or certificate; 18 19 (c) A divorce decree; 20 (d) A certificate of decree of adoption; (e) A court order changing the person's name; 21 (f) A Social Security card reflecting an updated name; and 22 23 (g) Naturalization papers or other documents from the United States Department of State 24 proving citizenship. 25 26 Any individual seeking one of the above documents in order to obtain a form of personal 27 identification described in subsection 1 of this section [in order to vote] for voting may request the secretary of state to facilitate the acquisition of such documents. The secretary of state shall pay any 28 29 fee or fees charged by another state or its agencies, or any court of competent jurisdiction in this 30 state or any other state, or the federal government or its agencies, in order to obtain any of the above 31 documents from such state or the federal government. 32 (3) All costs associated with the implementation of this section shall be reimbursed from the 33 general revenue of this state by an appropriation for that purpose.
