1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 555, Page 10, Section 67.2689, Line 43,  
2 by inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "92.117. 1. Any city not within a county that imposes or levies an earnings tax under  
5 sections 92.105 to 92.200 shall submit to the qualified voters of such city on the next general  
6 municipal election date immediately following August 28, 2021, the question of whether to exempt  
7 workers who are paid wages at the minimum wage rate described under section 290.502 from the  
8 earnings tax.

9 2. The question submitted to the qualified voters in any such city shall contain substantially  
10 the following language:

11 Shall workers who are paid the minimum wage rate for their services be exempted  
12 from the earnings tax in this city, currently levied and imposed at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_  
13 percent?

15 3. (1) If the question described in subsection 2 is approved by the majority of qualified  
16 voters voting thereon, effective January first of the calendar year immediately following the  
17 calendar year in which the question is approved, there shall be no earnings tax levied and imposed  
18 in the city on any workers who are paid wages at the minimum wage rate described under section  
19 290.502.

20 (2) If the question described in subsection 2 is not approved by the majority of qualified  
21 voters voting thereon, workers who are paid wages at the minimum wage rate described under  
22 section 290.502 shall continue to remain subject to the earnings tax and the earnings tax shall  
23 continue to be levied and imposed according to all applicable provisions of sections 92.105 to  
24 92.200."; and

26 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
27 accordingly.
