2. Each public governmental body shall make available for inspection and copying by the public of that body's public records. No person shall remove original public records from the office of a public governmental body or its custodian without written permission of the designated custodian. No public governmental body shall, after August 28, 1998, grant to any person or entity,
whether by contract, license or otherwise, the exclusive right to access and disseminate any public record unless the granting of such right is necessary to facilitate coordination with, or uniformity among, industry regulators having similar authority.

Each request for access to a public record shall be acted upon as soon as possible, but in 1 2 no event later than the end of the third business day following the date the request is received by the 3 custodian of records of a public governmental body, unless published notice is provided at least seventy-two hours prior to the request for records that the public governmental body will be closed 4 5 for an extended period outside of normal hours of operation. If records are requested in a certain 6 format, the public body shall provide the records in the requested format, if such format is available. 7 If access to the public record is not granted immediately, the custodian shall give a detailed 8 explanation of the cause for further delay and the place and earliest time and date that the record 9 will be available for inspection. This period for document production may exceed three days for 10 reasonable cause. 11 4.
