1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 744, Page 4, Section 455.040, Line 94, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "575.205. 1. A person commits the offense of tampering with electronic monitoring  
5 equipment if he or she intentionally removes, alters, tampers with, damages, ~~or~~ destroys, fails to  
6 charge, or otherwise disables electronic monitoring equipment which a court or the board of  
7 probation and parole has required such person to wear.

8 2. This section does not apply to the owner of the equipment or an agent of the owner who  
9 is performing ordinary maintenance or repairs on the equipment.

10 3. The offense of tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is a class D felony.

11 4. The offense of tampering with electronic monitoring equipment if a person fails to charge  
12 or otherwise disables electronic monitoring equipment is a class E felony, unless the offense for  
13 which the person was placed on electronic monitoring was a misdemeanor, in which case it is a class  
14 A misdemeanor."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
17 accordingly.
