1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1030, Page 3, Section 105.1500, Line 58,  
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "Section 1. 1. No entity in this state shall require documentation of an individual having  
5 received a vaccination against any disease in order for the individual to access transportation  
6 systems or services, including but not limited to buses, air travel, rail travel, taxicab or limousine  
7 services, prearranged rides as defined in section 387.400, other public transportation, or any public  
8 transportation facilities, including but not limited to bus and airport facilities.

9 2. No Missouri government entity, subdivision, agency, or agent, is authorized to issue  
10 vaccine passports, vaccine passes, or other standardized documentation for the purpose of certifying  
11 an individual's COVID-19 vaccination status to a third party, or otherwise publish or share any  
12 individual's COVID-19 vaccination record or similar health information.

13 3. Missouri business entities are prohibited from requiring patrons or customers to provide  
14 any documentation certifying COVID-19 vaccination or post-transmission recovery to gain access  
15 to, entry upon, or service from the business entity.

16 4. All businesses must comply with this act to be eligible for grants or contracts funded  
17 through state revenue.

18 5. The requirements in this act do not otherwise restrict businesses from instituting COVID-  
19 19 screening protocols in accordance with state and federal law to protect public health, and nothing  
20 herein shall be construed to interfere with individuals' rights to access their own personal health  
21 information under federal law."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
24 accordingly.
