| 16 | veteran status. |
| 17 | 3. (1) The governor shall, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, appoint an |
| 18 | officer to head the Missouri office of equal opportunity. |
| 19 | (2) Subject to appropriations, the commissioner of administration shall provide the officer |
| 20 | with such facilities, staff, resources, equipment, and supplies as are necessary to carry out the duties |
| 21 | set forth herein. The officer shall submit a proposal each fiscal year to the commissioner of |
| 22 | administration detailing the needs of the Missouri office of equal opportunity. |
| 23 | (3) The officer shall be the state's chief compliance officer to ensure that the state is |
| 24 | complying with all federal and state laws concerning equal employment opportunity and workforce |
| 25 | diversity. |
| 26 | 4. The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall have the following duties and |
| 27 | responsibilities: |
| 28 | (1) To assist in the coordination and implementation of workforce diversity programs |
| 29 | throughout all departments and offices of state government; |
| 30 | (2) To advise the governor on issues regarding equal employment opportunity, workforce |
| 31 | diversity, efforts to administer workforce diversity action goals, and timetables for implementation |
| 32 | throughout the departments and offices of state government; |
| 33 | (3) To review progress reports of state departments and offices and meet biannually with |
| 34 | each department director to evaluate departmental results and determine the course of future |
