1 AMEND House Substitute for House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 520, Page 15, Section 302.171, Line 127, by inserting after all of said section and  
3 line the following:

5 "313.303. 1. The lottery commission, the state lottery or any employee of the state lottery,  
6 or any organization with whom the state has contracted to operate the state lottery or any of that  
7 organization's employees shall not publish the name, address, or any other identifying information  
8 of any person who wins the state lottery.

9 2. As used in this section, "publish" means to issue information or material in printed or  
10 electronic form for distribution or sale to the public.

11 3. Any person or entity who violates the provisions of this section by publishing identifying  
12 information protected under this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

13 4. (1) This section shall not apply to any entity described in subsection 1 of this section if  
14 the person who wins the state lottery authorizes in writing, on a form to be provided by the lottery  
15 commission, the public disclosure of his or her name, address, or any other identifying information.

16 (2) The form provided by the lottery commission under subdivision (1) of this subsection  
17 shall only be provided upon the request of a lottery winner and shall not be offered unsolicited, and  
18 shall clearly state in no less than fourteen-point bolded font at the top of such form that the signing  
19 of such form allowing the public disclosure of identifying information is not required for the person  
20 to claim his or her lottery winnings, and that the person may claim his or her lottery winnings while  
21 remaining anonymous to the public."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
24 accordingly.
