FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§188.035 - Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office (AGO)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes, in response to similar legislation from 2020 (HB 1539), the AGO assumed any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing personnel and resources. The AGO also stated they may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary and assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact on the AGO.

Oversight notes the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Public Safety, Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the Office of State Public Defender, and the Hermann Area Hospital District have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Oversight notes, in response to similar provisions from 2020 (SB 665), officials from the **Department of Corrections (DOC)** stated although the bill repeals the potential to charge someone with murder in the second degree, which is a class A felony, DOC records do not allow for the identification of individuals whose convictions are based on actions outlined in the proposed legislation. Therefore, the DOC assumes no fiscal impact as a result of this proposal.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect the no fiscal impact provided by DOC for fiscal note purposes.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
