FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

<u>§§167.181, 167.186, 174.335, 210.003, 210.110, 210.115, 334.099, 334.100, and 334.291 –</u> <u>Immunizations</u>

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS)** state the proposed legislation would require the department to develop and make available online an informational brochure outlining how to obtain an exemption. The brochure must also include the exemption forms and the statement that an unimmunized student with an exemption cannot be prohibited from attending: a public school, a public institution of higher education, public day care center, preschool or nursery school. It will require a Public Health Program Specialist four hours to compile the information to create a conscientious exemption form and a brochure informing parents how to obtain exemption forms as well as copies of all the exemption forms. The annual average salary for a Public Health Program Specialist is \$45,638, which would result in a cost of \$87.76 one-time [\$21.94 x 4]. Therefore, the Bureau anticipates being able to absorb these costs. However, until the FY22 budget is final, the department cannot identify specific funding sources.

A Lead Administrative Support Assistant would need to create an Office of Public Information (OPI) Project Request form. These duties that take, on average, 1 hour per request. The average annual salary for a Lead Administrative Support Assistant is \$32,668, which would result in a cost of \$15.71 (\$15.71 x 1). After the request form has been drafted and approved through the approval process by the division, the requests will be posted on the department website. The department anticipates being able to absorb these costs. However, until the FY22 budget is final, the department cannot identify specific funding sources.

In summary, DHSS assumes an absorbable cost of \$103.47 in FY 2022 to provide for the implementation of the changes in this proposal. **Oversight** assumes the DHSS has sufficient staff and resources available to absorb the additional duties required by this proposal.

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Social Services, the Malta Bend R-V School District, Missouri State University, University of Central Missouri, University of Missouri, State Technical College of Missouri, and the Hermann Area Hospital District each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts, hospitals and colleges and universities were
