FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Elections** assume a cost of \$75,000 to hold a countywide recall election from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation from 2019, HB 580, officials at **Greene County** assumed a cost to hold a special election of \$110,000 from this proposal.

Oversight will reflect a ranged fiscal impact from \$0 (no recall petitions filed) to an unknown impact to counties for the potential costs involved in verifying signatures and holding a special election for the removal of the commissioner.

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **St. Louis County Board of Elections** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary and will reflect no fiscal impact for the Office of the Secretary of State and the St. Louis County Board of Elections.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation, but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
