## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.

Officials from the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** estimate this would take 15 hours per sub-district to draw. With that in mind, they estimate that they would have to draw 63 sub-districts for the 9 impacted school districts. This would entail 945 hours of programming at a cost of \$24.00 per hour for a total of \$22,680.

In response to a similar proposal, HB 1117 (2019), the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** indicated this would impact the following school districts:

- 1. Castle Point
  - a. Riverview Gardens
  - b. Hazelwood
  - c. Ferguson
  - d. Florissant
- 2. Wheaton-Cook-Lyndhurst
  - a. Normandy
  - b. Ritenour
  - c. University City
- 3. Elmwood Park
  - a. Pattonville
  - b. Ladue

**Oversight** received no responses from school districts related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other School Districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

## FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County to establish seven sub-districts for any school district in St. Louis County that is within, or adjoining another school district that is within, a street light maintenance district with a population less than 3,000. The sub-districts will be established for the purpose of electing school district directors. The bill specifies how the sub-district boundaries will be drawn.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
