Officials from the **Department of Public Safety, Missouri Highway Patrol (DPS/MHP)** defer to the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

Oversight notes DPS/MHP's deferral to MoDOT for a statement of fiscal impact; for fiscal note purposes, Oversight assumes no fiscal impact for DPS/MHP.
