FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Fordland School District** state this proposal would have an impact, but did not elaborate.

In response to a similar proposal from 2020 (HB 1636), Officials from the **New Bloomfield School District** stated this proposal has no direct fiscal impact on their school district.

Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive in nature and would not have a direct fiscal impact on state government or on the school districts in the state.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
