#### **ASSUMPTION**

### §21.750 - Preemption of firearms regulation

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing personnel and resources. However, the AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the City of Ballwin, the City of Corder, the City of Kansas City, the City of O'Fallon, the City of Springfield, the City of St. Louis, the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the Crestwood Police Department, the Ellisville Police Department, the Kansas City Police Department, the Springfield Police Department, and the St. Louis County Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the City of Hale responded to the legislation but did not provide a fiscal impact.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, and police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
