ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety's Office of the Director**, the **Missouri Department of Agriculture** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Office**, the **Crestwood Police Department**, the **Ellisville Police Department**, the **Kansas City Police Department**, the **St. Joseph Police Department**, the **St. Louis County Police Department**, the **Claycomo Fire Department**, the **Fredericktown Fire Department**, the **Gainesville Fire Department**, the **Kearney Fire & Rescue Protection District**, the **Metro West Fire Protection District**, the **Mid County Fire Protection District/Camdenton Fire Department**, the **Plato Rural Fire Protection Association**, the **Valley Park Fire Protection District**, the **Wentzville Fire Protection District**, the **Wheeling Rural Fire District**, the **Barry County 911 Board**, the **Caldwell County Ambulance District**, the **Crawford County 911 Board**, the **Nodaway County Ambulance District** and the **West County EMS & FPD** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from 2020, HB 1269, officials at the **Springfield Police Department** assumed no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight has requested additional information from the **St. Clair Fire Protection District** regarding their response. Upon the receipt of this information, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note if needed.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other law enforcement agencies, fire protection districts and ambulance and EMS districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


