In response to similar legislation from this year (SB 306), officials from the cities of **Brentwood**, **Norborne**, **Southwest City**, **St. Louis** and **Tipton** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. §§537.346 & 537.347 – Landowner liability if owner invites person on land for recreational purposes
