ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Attorney General's Office, Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Office of Administration – Budget & Planning, Department of Commerce and Insurance, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Mental Health, Department of Natural **Resources, Department of Corrections, Department of Revenue, Department of Public** Safety – Alcohol and Tobacco Control, Capital Police, Fire Safety, Director's Office, Gaming Commission, National Guard, Highway Patrol, Veterans Commission, Department of Social Services, Missouri Department of Agriculture, Missouri Ethics Commission, Missouri Department of Transportation, MoDOT & Patrol Employees' Retirement System, Office off Administration, Office of the Secretary of State, Office of the State Public Defender, Office of the State Treasurer, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Join Committee on Education, Missouri House of Representative, Legislative Research, **Oversight Division, Missouri Lottery, Economic & Policy Analysis Research Center,** Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Missouri Higher Education Loan Authority, Missouri State Employee's Retirement System, Office of the State Courts Administrator, and State Tax Commission each assume the proposal would not have direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above organizations have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note

Officials from the **City of Hale** assume the proposal would have negative fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes the City of Hale indicated this proposal would have an unknown negative impact; however, Oversight is unable to project a statewide cost. Oversight will show zero impact to local governments-political subdivisions on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **City of Ballwin**, **Corder**, **Kansas City**, and **Saint Louis – Budget Division** each assume the proposal would not have direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Officials from the University of Missouri, Missouri State University, Truman State University, University Of Central Missouri and State Technical College of Missouri each assume the proposal would have no direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

<u>ASSUMPTION</u> (continued)

Officials from the **Affton School District** assume the proposal would not have direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Oversight notes that the local governments-political subdivisions, colleges, and school have generally stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other state agencies, local governments, colleges, and school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
