# **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

In response to a previous version, officials from the Missouri Department of Agriculture, Department of Natural Resources, Attorney General's Office, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Corrections and Office of the State Public Defender each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services (MOPS)** assume the proposal will have no measurable fiscal impact on MOPS. The creation of a new crime creates additional responsibilities for county prosecutors which may, in turn, result in additional costs, which are difficult to determine.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the Boone County/City of Columbia Health Department and Newton County Health Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **St. Louis County Health Department** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other county health departments and sheriffs were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
