FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency.

In response to a previous version of the proposal, officials from the **Fordland School District** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their district.

Officials from the **High Point R-III School District** stated the bill would have a fiscal impact but did not elaborate.

Oversight notes that some of the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Oversight assumes the proposal would not have a material direct fiscal impact on school districts. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, many other school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
