FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§571.101 and 571.107 – Allows firearms in churches or places of worship

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety** – (**Missouri Highway Patrol** and **Missouri National Guard**), and the **Kansas City Police Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the Crestwood Police Department, the Ellisville Police Department, and the Springfield Police Department each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight notes this bill lowers the age requirement from nineteen to eighteen for a concealed carry permit, which may increase the number of CCW applications submitted to county sheriffs. Oversight assumes some of the increase in revenue to sheriff's departments will be offset by an increase in cost to process the applications for CCW permits.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
