#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Department of Transportation**, the **Department of Public Safety** - **Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Office of Administration**, the **Department of Social Services** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight assumes this proposal will have no fiscal impact on local governments.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
