FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Department of Transportation**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Office of Administration** and the **Department of Social Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Missouri Department of Conservation** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight assumes this proposal will have no fiscal impact on local governments.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
