FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC)** state this proposed legislation requires new preferences in regards to the occupancy of Missouri's Low Income Housing. MHDC does not anticipate this proposed legislation will result in direct fiscal impact to the State of Missouri.

However, the occupancy preferences required under this proposed legislation could raise fair housing issues; the occupancy preferences proposed would apply to all MHDC developments, regardless of the development type (senior, special needs housing, or family developments). Many MHDC properties have waiting lists for occupancy. This proposed legislation would automatically require that veterans and seniors be placed at the top of those waiting lists for any MHDC development. The difference in treatment of one potential resident receives over another may trigger legal issues for the state for which the fiscal impact cannot be known.

Oversight notes MHDC assumes this proposed legislation will not result in a direct fiscal impact, but could result in future additional litigation. For purposes of this fiscal note, Oversight will not report a fiscal impact for this proposed legislation. Oversight assumes any costs incurred as a result of future additional litigation occur to be an indirect impact of this proposed legislation.

Officials from the Office of Administration – Budget & Planning, the Missouri Department of Revenue, the City of Corder, the City of Kansas City, the City of O'Fallon, and the City of Springfield do not anticipate this proposed legislation will cause a fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will not report a fiscal impact for these organizations.
